The Board Selectmen voted at their meeting of May 5, 2014 to endorse the Police Station Renovation and Addition Project, the warrant article to be presented to Town Meeting, and the debt exclusion ballot question that will be presented to the voters on June 14, 2014.

In 2012 funding was approved to study the feasibility of renovating and expanding the existing police station, and in 2013, funding was approved to complete the design of the renovation and addition to the existing station.


This is an extremely important project for our community. Not only will it finally give our community a modern police station that will meet our needs for years to come, it will also protect and preserve one of our most significant historic structures.
